THE VINEYARD

Spiriterra Vineyards is a small, family-owned vineyard located in the Howell Mountain hills area east of St. Helena. 100% of our grapes are hand picked from our estate ensuring only the highest quality grapes go into our wine. Spiriterra Vineyards is geographically blessed with incredible soils, good mountainside drainage, excellent sun exposure, and extraordinary growing conditions. Long, warm days and cool nights, which allow for a slow accumulation of sugar, provide ideal conditions for properly ripening our grapes.

In 2009 we planted our, and Napa Valley's, first experimental Muscadine vineyard. Spiriterra Vineyards proprietor, Paul Dean, grew up in rural Georgia and wanted to bring a bit of his southern upbringing to the Napa Valley. These native grapes of North America are traditionally grown in the southeastern United States and have been cultivated for more than 400 years for the production of commercial fine wines and ports. The grapes are thriving here in the Napa Valley and our vineyard has expanded to two acres.

WINEMAKER TASTING NOTES

Beautiful light golden color with fragrant, exotic aromas of quince and loquat. The aromas carry nicely into the mouth and are accented by a tart apple crispness. The finish is crisp and clean with the lingering fragrance begging for another sip. Try it with spicy Asian or Mexican dishes to quench the fire and soothe the palate.
